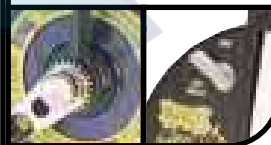

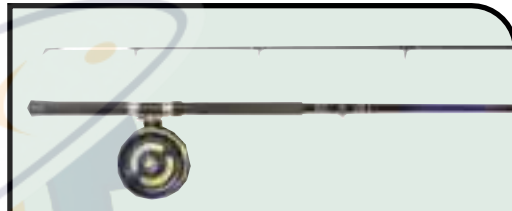

The only essential requirement in sidecast angling is that an ordinary small free running swivel be placed above your rig. Any type of rig, spinner or float can be used below the swivel, but nothing on or attached to the line above it. In this position the swivel will, for all practical purposes, keep your line free of twist from any cause whatsoever. The use of too large a swivel is often another cause of line twist, the swivel being too heavy for the light line to turn. For the estuary no swivel larger than no.12 should be necessary.

Thanks to the extremely reliable, effective construction of all Alvey reels they have become a tradition on many Australian beaches. It doesn't really matter which Alvey reel you decide to use, you are assured that if you can take it, your reel can too. When surf fishing it is almost impossible to keep sand out of your reel. Alvey reels are in fact so tough we recommend dunking them in the surf for a quick rinse should the need arise. Simply wash it with fresh water before storage. *(Note: All these Alvey reels are also available in left hand).*



great surf fish recipes from Jack Mac

Snapper in Milk - Serves: 4-6

1 snapper (about 2.5 kg)	500ml milk
250gm grated strong cheese	3 tomatoes
2 large white onions	salt and pepper

Clean and scale the fish. Slice fish to the backbone on both sides. Place in a baking dish and pour over the milk. Slice the white onion and tomatoes, and add to the fish. Season with salt and pepper, then cover. Bake in a moderate oven until flesh flakes from the bones. Add the grated cheese and cook for another five minutes before serving.

Tailor in Creole Sauce - Serves: 4

4 tailor fillets (cubed)	1 sliced black olive
2 tablespoons chopped onions	1 small tin champignons
2 knobs butter	2 nips medium sweet sherry
2 tomatoes	pinch salt and pepper

Saute the onions and the tomatoes in the butter for two to three minutes. Add all other ingredients except sherry. Cook until fish is tender. Add the sherry just before serving and heat through. Serve with boiled rice.
