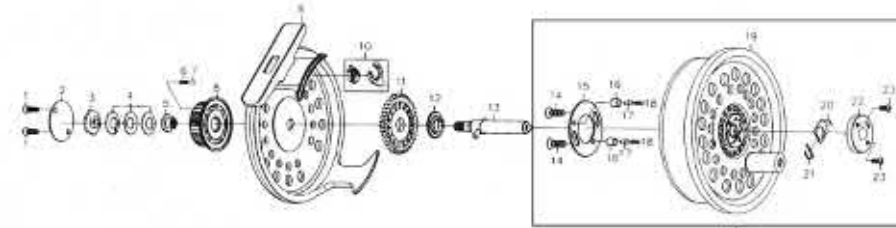

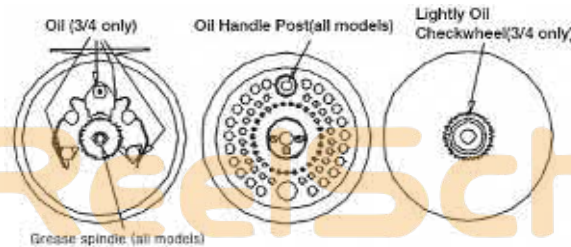


With care and periodic cleaning, your reel will serve you with years of excellent performance.

Care & Maintenance

The same method of cleaning is valid for all reels in the Monarch series.

1. Remove line and backing.
2. Remove the spool.
3. Flush away dirt by placing the spool and frame under a stream of warm water.
4. Dry carefully with a lint free cloth.
5. Lubricate with a good quality oil of the points illustrated on the diagrams.
6. Always ensure the spindle is adequately greased.
7. Always turn the drag to the minimum setting to avoid compression of the pad.
8. Always ensure the reel and line are dry before storing in the case or pouch.

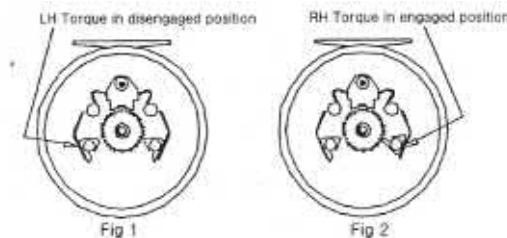


Changing your reel from left to right hand wind

All Monarch reels are designed to work in right and left hand wind. When you receive your reel. It will be set for left hand wind.

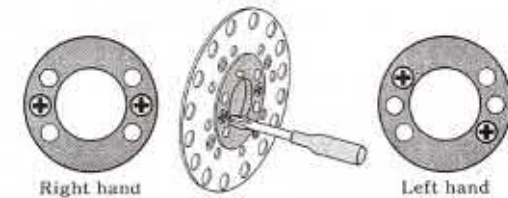
To convert your reel to right hand wind (3/4)

1. Remove the spool out of the frame
2. Switch the left hand tongue into the disengaged position As shown in fig 1
3. Switch the right hand tongue into the engaged position As shown in fig 2
4. Refit the spool into the frame



To convert your reel to right hand wind (5/6, 7/8 only)

1. Remove the spool out of the frame.
2. Turn the spool over so that the 2 fixing screws are visible.
3. Using a good fitting screwdriver, remove the 2 fixing screws from the housing plate.
4. Rotate the housing plate a few degrees counter-clockwise to locate alternate screw holes.
5. Replace the 2 fixing screws.
6. Replace the spool into the frame - your reel should now be right hand wind.



Series drag system (5/6, 7/8 only)

The drag mechanism can be adjusted by simply turning the drag knob on the face of the drum, clockwise to increase the drag, counter-clockwise to decrease the drag. When the reel is not in use, the drag should be turned to the lowest setting.
